The Healthcare Affordability Fund is a targeted, sustainable funding source that makes affordable healthcare options available to more New Mexicans by:

- Lowering premiums for small businesses
- · Lowering costs on the Exchange
- Providing \$0 premium plans to Native Americans who make under 3x the federal poverty line

HB 7 keeps funding levels constant so healthcare programs won't be cut

- From 2022 to July 2024, 55% of the revenue goes to the Healthcare Affordability Fund.
- Starting July 2024, only 30% of the revenue goes to the Healthcare
 Affordability Fund—which will significantly decrease the amount of money it receives each year (\$66-\$76 million less each year).

The 2024 cut in revenue threatens critical healthcare programs the Healthcare Affordability Fund is making a reality.
